## Connecting the dots: Urban, Regional and High Speed Rail

### About the Program:

With the passage of Measure R, Metro is almost doubling the amount of their rail service in the Los Angeles region. Metro is also the proud owner of Union Station. In addition, Metro is developing grade separations and other grade crossing improvement projects while working on the Southern California Regional Interconnector Project (SCRIP). Metrolink will be the first railroad in the county to implement Positive Train Control, and is now developing their Ten Year Strategic Plan that will move them into the future. In addition, they are investing in Tier Four locomotives that will be the cleanest running in the nation. CHSRA has broken ground on several rail segments, and is now looking again at directly connecting to Union Station in Los Angeles.

The agencies will provide the urban, regional and HSR perspectives and an overview and status of their various rail projects, and how they envision how we should “connect the dots” and interface with each other at Union Station.
