### Program Description:

For the second year in a row, L.A. reported the largest number of chronically homeless people in the nation — nearly 13,000 — a result of skyrocketing rents and lack of affordable housing. We need 382,000 new units just to meet current demand. Furthermore, LA's population is projected to increase by a half a million in 20 years! Now, Angelenos and the AEC industry must consider Measure S: if it passes on March 7, a two-year moratorium on projects seeking a zoning change and height increase will be imposed. How will this affect affordable housing, TODs, rents, homelessness, and AEC jobs in Southern California? Development and land use leaders will answer these questions and discuss how this significant legislation will impact the AEC industry.
